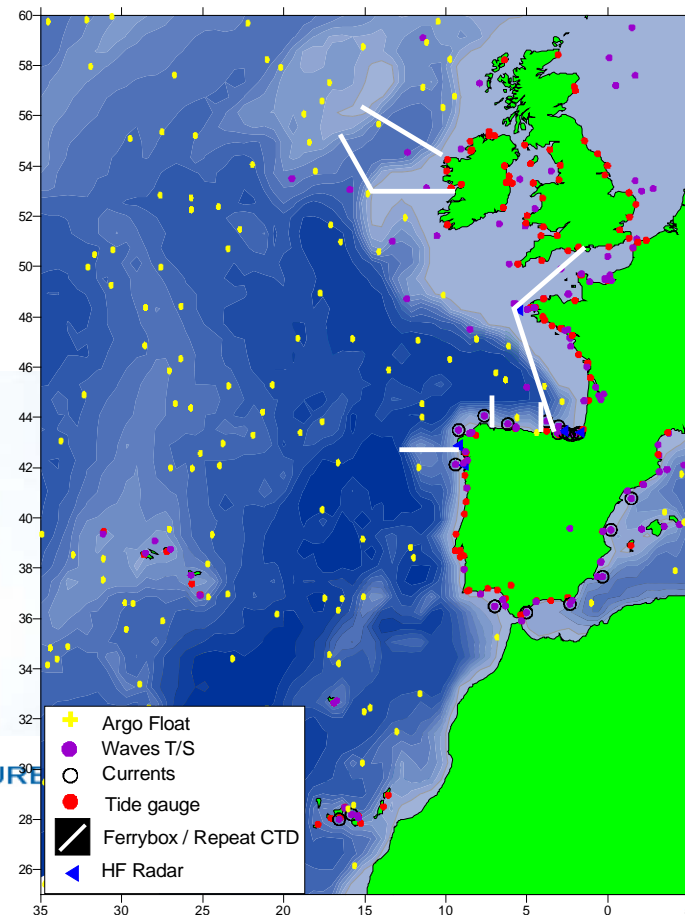

2006/2007: FCT type entity became an objective of the EuroGOOS Technology Plan Working Group

2007: EuroGOOS hosted TPWG event in Trieste (strong company participation and some collaborations)
